1. Approve minutes from March 4, 2026 meeting (are there minutes?) – only closed session
2. Review of membership form – approved – great simplification
3. Accessibility and UDL – workloads, UDL – architecture and engineering around accessibility, student choice in how you evaluate them – their choice how to present material – multiple rubrics
 - Union needs to fight for support and compensation – is it realistic what is being asked of us?
 - How can the Union protect our faculty from not being able to meet all the accessible needs?
 - Need guidelines – what is the minimum required?
 - Unfunded mandate – Wendy at FACCC, Kay (CCCI President) – sounds like a COFO thing – ASCCC meet – where the unions meet to build consensus around faculty issues. Jesse has reached out to all of them. Problematic – huge impact
4. General Strike – Calls for general strike on May Day. May resistance training – historically important. This is May 1st on a Friday. Negotiations scheduled for that day. How would we feel for faculty to participate in May Day – members participate in no work, no school, no commerce. Collective resistance. Some concerns regarding labs and student load. Reach out to ASOC. Let's get more involved.
